

## **GRADUATE GUIDANCE COMMITTEE**

The ACM&MS Graduate Guidance Committee (GGC) is expected to share responsibility for reviewing the graduate student's progress, guiding the student toward completion of course and program requirements, and preparing the student for professional success after graduation. The student's GGC will be formed no later than the **end of the second semester** and should consist of at least three members.

It is the student's responsibility to make the selection and gain permissions. Most importantly, choose members based on who you know in the program and who has the expertise and connections related to your interests. The GGC will consist of a majority ACM&MS faculty and may also include an approved (by Program Director, then Graduate School) member of the student's topic area or professional practice related to the program work.

To change the composition of an existing committee, the student must confer first with their Chair and then Program Director.
